

Minimising disruption for residents & businesses



We know construction can be disruptive. While there will be times when its unavoidable, we want to do everything we can to make the process more manageable for you and hope that you will work with us in achieving that aim. Here are some of the measures we're taking.

- **Visiting businesses:** we'll come and talk to you about what you'll need during construction, and find solutions to issues like deliveries. We can also supply you with Business As Usual signs.
- **Starting with improvements:** where possible we'll upgrade car parks before the main works begin on the high street.
- **Working in phases:** we'll complete the scheme in stages, so it happens quickly but with as little disruption as possible.
- **Avoiding busy times:** we'll plan ahead so that we're not working in high street areas at popular shopping times.
- **Being flexible:** if problems crop up while we're working we'll try to work around them, changing our schedule if necessary.
- **Keeping you moving:** we'll create temporary crossings, so you can still get around safely.
- **Showing you the way:** we'll put signs up to direct you around our construction works.
