

Outline design for Enfield Town to Broxbourne Walking & Cycling Route

Enfield Council are exploring the feasibility of a new walking and cycling link and conducting engagement with local stakeholders on early concept designs.

It is proposed that the Enfield Town to Broxbourne Walking and Cycling Route (within the borders of Enfield) runs from the southern side of the M25 junction with the A10 initially along the New River and eventually on the local highway network towards Enfield Town. The total length for the section within Enfield is approximately 4.7km. It features the construction of a shared use cycle path running for 2.9km adjacent to the New River, and 1.8km of cycling routes using local roads. Broxbourne Council are also working with Highways England on a related project that extends the route into Broxbourne.
